

Applied Compositional Thinking for Engineers (ACT4E) - January 2021

A **new online free course** on Applied Compositional Thinking for engineers, open to **everyone** interested in learning how concepts from category theory can be made useful for tackling engineering problems. No special background knowledge needed.
